



The Panafrican Caucus

Presentation

The State of the African Diaspora is willing to invite the World Conference of Mayors, the National Policy Alliance (NPA), the Congressional Black Caucus (CBC) and the National Black Caucus of State Legislators (NBCSL) to create together the Panafrican Caucus : the objective is to fight for economic development and social justice for People of African Descent, on a national and international level.

Composition

The Panafrican Caucus will include two kinds of members from Africa or from the Diaspora:

- Politicians of African Descent,
- Organisations of Politicians of African Descent.

Strategy and Calendar

Differents steps will lead to the creation of the SOAD Panafrican Caucus :

- Until January 27th 2021 : Written Answers of the Organisations invited to participate to the Panafrican Caucus
- January 29th 2021 : Public Announcement of the Panafrican Caucus by the Prime Minister of the State of the African Diaspora during the World Conference of Mayors
- January 31st : Meeting on Zoom 6PM GMT to solidify the organisation and plannify the future activities.

Examples of Campaigns

These are some campaigns that the Panafrican Caucus could lead in the future :

- 1) Fight against contemporary slavery in Western Africa

The Prime Minister of the State of the African Diaspora is working with the President of Mauritania on a campaign on this topic. The Panafrican Caucus could work also on this initiative.

- 2) Construction of Smart cities in Africa and in the Diaspora

The State of the African Diaspora is working on more than 30 smart cities in Africa and the Diaspora. The Panafrican Caucus might be willing to work on these topics.
