
LEADER OF "THE MISSION"



Mr. Hugh Johnson

Mr. Johnson is Vice Prime Minister of the State of the African Diaspora (SOAD) and President of the 6th Economic Region of Africa (ECO-6) and Executive Chairman of the Jamaica Lumineers Secretariat. He galvanized the support of agencies, locally and internationally, within the agricultural framework through his organic fertilizer company, founded in 1996. He is co-Founder of the World Cocoa Farmers Association (WCFO).

Dr Hamet Maulana

Dr. Mualana is Founder of the Ministry of the Future (MOF) which made history in Ghana on December 28, 2016, when the MOF facilitated 34 Africans of the Diaspora to be granted Ghanaian Citizenship, giving them: "THE RIGHT TO RETURN". This was the first time this had ever happened in Africa.

Through the MOF's due diligence of lobbying, advocacy and outreach they were successful in getting 232 Africans of the Diaspora approved for Ghanaian Citizenship in 2019, (126 were sworn in November 2019 and 124 throughout 2021).




Dr Foster Larbi
